The Parliamentary Procedure and Debate Curricular Code meeting was called to order on June 27 at 8:59 AM by Brittney Thompson. The committee discussed four proposed changes. The motion passed to delete rule II relating to indicating if the state winning team is comprised of freshmen and below by state finals. Motions passed relating to clarification of wording and deleting repetitive statements in the code. The following rules had wording changed or deleted: Rule IV (repetitive wording related to making motions in a demonstration), Rule V (qualifying teams from sectional and regional contests), Rule A (teams seeded into state finals rooms based on test scores), Rule B and Rule C (using index cards for motions), and Rule J (debate topics coming from state and nationally recognized FFA activities). Motion passed to change all language on the curricular code and score cards to 11 minutes. Motions passed that all individual oral questions and test questions must come from Dunbar's Manual of Parliamentary Procedure Test questions and Dunbar's Parliamentary Procedures Oral Questions Challenge questions bank. Motion passed to limit the number of debatable subsidiary motions on the card to two for the novice portion of the contest. Motion passed relating to 7th and 8th grade students competing several years in a row: if a 7th or 8th grader competes at the state finals contest, they forfeit their eligibility to compete on a novice team the subsequent year. They can compete at any other contest. Meeting adjourned at 9:51 AM.
